

The post is extremely solvent and stable and preparing for the future due solely to the commitment of our membership, past and present.

Commander Dehnke, and Senior Vice Beseler along with the membership worked very hard at recruiting new members. This herculean effort resulting in an incredible 114% membership status for the year. More than just the numbers, our goal is involvement, please continue influence the membership to attend meetings either virtually or in person. Our ability to sustain the post into the next generation absolutely relies on active membership, please continue to invite members to participate.

Financially we faced some challenges with some reduced revenues due to the effects of inflation and increased product costs; however, this is important, our patronage did not fall off. The loyalty of the community and their support in 2022 cannot be overlooked, even in trying times they showed up to not only our charcoal chicken, but the ham and turkey raffle as well. Please continue to thank them! The Ham and Turkey was again a complete success! I would like to thank Stan Swenson, Gary Krause, and Jim and Kim Goss for perfecting and streamlining the organization of the raffle, it has made the job of managing that event super easy and with Laura looking over my shoulder how can it go wrong!

31 Guns in 31 Days.... Thank you to all those who sold tickets especially our top sellers, Ratz, Dehnke, Beseler and Kamrowski. What a huge success! Post Adjutant Doug Ratz, in conjunction with the Post Service Officer Jim Goss and Caleb Olsen of Caleb Olsen Guns, put together a raffle that has insured our ability to fund future post capital projects.... So, there is a need for a 2023 Gun Raffle, and it is currently in progress, guns are purchased and tickets are out! This is a good seque to the future.

The roof! The club, as you are all aware has undergone a face lift over the last few years. Led by the Club Manager Les Kamrowski and his wife Sharon and a tremendous group of volunteers from the post and Auxiliary, the club room and hall has had many repairs and updates. In 2022, we had some expensive capital items that needed replacement. These expenses included our furnace in the back room and the industrial refrigerator in the kitchen, both gave out on us due to old age. With those two unbudgeted expenses we need to refill the building fund for the future and that future looks like a new roof. We are look at an approximate \$25-30K roof replacement in 2023. By completing this project, we will ensure the structural longevity of our post into the next generation and removes the burden on post members in the future to make the repair.


