

Hunts For Heroes

Hard to know where to start on this subject because it's such a heart moving thing one veteran, many supporting people, businesses and our VFW Post has been a part of.

Post member Kyle Bushman has "coordinated" all, heck, he has simply done it! During hunting season 2015 Kyle and associates gathered 7 disabled veterans from Florida, Indiana, Minnesota, Iowa and Wisconsin for pheasant, duck and deer hunting. Their disabilities ranged from double leg amputees to lesser but disabling combat injuries sustained in several different wars. I cannot put into words the experience these wounded vets had once again pursuing hunting activities, something they never dreamed they would do again. That is until Kyle Bushman, a partner in a very large agriculture operation, a SGT in an Army Reserve unit at Fort McCoy, a fellow combat veteran and a good VFW member started the "HUNTS FOR HEROES" program 5 years ago. Just the logistics of gathering vets from all around the country, arranging licenses, transportation, lodging, meals and the zillion other things that need to be done to make it all happen is mind boggling!



Numerous local people provided hunting land/facilities, meat processing, taxidermy services and monetary contributions. Our Post participated financially and with meals. THERE IS SO MUCH MORE THAT CAN AND MUST BE DONE!!!! This is one of those things that are just so RIGHT that you must support it whole heartedly; it's an opportunity to put our money where our mouth is.

One essential need is to obtain the usage of a specialized electric powered all terrain, track equipped chair for the double amputee vets to get to hunting places they can only look at without such a device. Perhaps the most important part of this program is the healing that takes place when vets who have given so much can get together 24/7 for a week or so and hunt together, live together and share that special camaraderie that only they who have experienced what they have can ever do.
