

I need to expand on some of the accomplishments of our post during 2018.

- 1. The post exceeded 100% in membership, i.e. we more than replaced members who moved/ transferred and our deceased members—no easy task! This means we grew in our ability to continue to do all the things we do for Veterans and our community.
- 2. We excelled in supporting the VFW youth programs. We conducted the patriotic writing/oral essay program, Voice of Democracy (VOD) for Senior High students at C-FC as well as the patriotic essay writing program, Patriots Pen for Junior High students at C-FC. VERY SIZABLE financial awards were given to the top 3 winners in each program.
- 3. We selected a "Teacher of the Year" at C-FC and forwarded his nomination thru the Wisconsin VFW system. Mr Janezich was this year's winner. This program/award recognizes a teacher that promotes patriotism in the classroom, school and community.
- 4. We give two VERY SIZABLE scholarships to C-FC graduating seniors. One for a 2-year institution and one for a 4-year collage.
- 5. The annual 4th of July Parade is 100% sponsored by the Post. We attracted approximately 4000 people this year to our little community before the rains came. This is done in support of the C-BC Lions Club 4th of July celebration. The profits the Lions Club makes from feeding, refreshing and entertaining this huge crowd is largely returned to our communities via their projects.
- 6. Each year our local C-FC School holds a "Military Night" which recognizes an honorary football team starting lineup of 11 veterans. Our post completely coordinates and "makes happen" everything on the veteran's side of the presentation.
- 7. We were the first charter financial supporter for our Buffalo County Quilts of Valor chapter. They have hand made with love, 77 quilts that have been presented to deserving area veterans with more to come! We continue to make cash donations to make this incredible activity possible.
- 8. We participate in our areas Memorial Day and Veterans Day programs. EVERY cemetery in the entire County where a veteran, some dating back to the Civil War, is buried has Memorial Day services conducted!
- 9. We provide Military Funeral Honors to ANY deceased veteran whose family requests such. We have no requirements of membership in the VFW. (Continued)

- 10. We maintain and make available a first-class club facility for use by local residents and organizations. This facility is essential to many activities in our little communities.
- 11. We conduct 8 charcoal chicken/brat events each year. We know our Post/Auxiliary put out the best chicken/brat dinner in the area!!!
- 12. In support of our basic core reason for being we provide unlimited support for veterans locally through the national level. All of the above activities require money--Lots of money! The Quartermaster gave a brief accounting of our income and donations. Our post donated over \$6,900.00 to just the above causes. There were MANY other donations also made!

Dennis Hoskins served in the U S Army during 1966-1968 to include a one-year combat tour in Vietnam as a logistical specialist. He has retired from a long career at Ashley Furniture in Arcadia. Dennis and his wife Trudy live in rural Fountain City.



Dave Florin graduated from C-FC in 1964. He served in the U S Air Force in 1968-1969 to include one year in Vietnam as a maintenance technician. He worked at Rohrer's Chevrolet Buick in Cochrane until retirement. His wife Sue was math teacher at C-FC. They live in Buffalo City.



Charles (Chuck) Bertrand: Chuck served in the U S Navy from 1963-1967 including a combat tour in Vietnam during 1965-1966. Chuck was a life long operator at the Dairyland Power generating station in Alma WI. Chuck lives in Buffalo City.



Richard (Dick) Brommerich originally from Winona MN served in the U S Marines 1957-1967 and in the U S Army 1974-1995. Dick is a Vietnam War Veteran. This 30-year career soldier retired at the rank of E-9, Command Sergeant Major-the highest enlisted rank in the US military. Dick and his wife reside in Buffalo City WI.



Leonard (Lenny) Litscher: Lenny is a 1961 C-FC graduate. He served in the U S Army during 1967-1968 including one year in Vietnam as a UH-1 (Huey) helicopter door gunner and crew chief. After leaving the military he operated the Litscher family farm. He has long served as the Chairman of the Town of Cross Board. Lenny and his wife live on the family farm in Bohris Valley, rural Fountain City.



Gene Brownell graduated from Pepin School in 1961, He served in the U S Army in 1968-1969 to include a one-year combat tour in Vietnam as a transportation specialist. He and his wife Judy owned and operated Judy and Gene's in Cochrane for many years. He has been a Buffalo City resident for nearly 50 years.
